Description of Course

NFPA 101, *Life Safety Code*, 2012 edition, was issued by NFPA on and approved as an American National Standard on August 31, 2011.

Significant changes have occurred in the 2012 edition, among which are:

- New definitions
- Elevators for occupant controlled evacuation
- Normally unoccupied building service equipment support areas
- Rewrite & expansion of Ch. 8 provisions on opening protective
- Carbon monoxide detection
- Health Care chapter provisions to make more homelike

The 8 hour class room instruction will cover the major changes to the 2012 Life Safety Code as follows:

- Core Chapters 1 thru 11
- Occupancy Chapters
 - Assembly
 - Health Care
 - Residential
 - Business
 - Building Rehabilitation

Attendees should have an intermediate level of NFPA 101 knowledge, and basic understanding of the structure, goals and objectives of such codes.

Presentation will be in the form of PowerPoint slides and verbal instructional discussions. It is highly recommended that attendee bring a copy of 2012 NFPA 101 to this class.

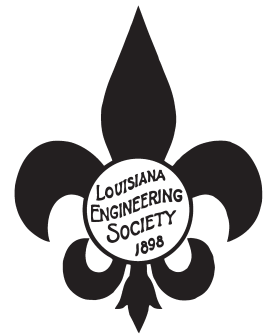
